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If you are a UK tax payer, under the Government's Gift Aid scheme, St George's Weybridge can claim the tax you have already paid on your gift. If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.

Notes:

1. You must pay an amount of income tax &/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that St George's Weybridge reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give).
2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying St George's via the Development Office.
3. If in the future your circumstances change & you no longer pay tax on your income or capital gains tax equal to the tax that St George's reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask St George's or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR 65.
6. Please notify St George's if you change your name or address.
